Women Against Violence and Expediency Handling Initiative (WAVEHI) NGO in partnership with the National Commission for Almajiri and Out-of-School children's Education Launched the community advocacy project Titled 'No Child Left Behind' in 2025. Carried out the 3-month ward level advocacy, working to ensure that all children have the right to quality education. And to develop and implement policies that support education for all, raising awareness on the issues of out-of-school children and mobilizing resources to support education programs

WAVEHI also continued their school programs of sensitizing and raising awareness on sexual health and sexual abuse to secondary school students according to World Health Organization guidelines.

WAVEHI also collaborated with Health Aid for All Initiative (HAIFAHAIFA), to commemorate the International day of the girl-child which takes place every year on the 11<sup>th</sup> of October. This Program was funded by Globacom Network.

WAVEHI's **Income of 50,000 US dollar for the year 2025** concluded step one of our NGO transformation.

1. WAVEHI NGO had a virtual conversation on zoom on the 1<sup>st</sup> of December, 2025 to commemorate the 16 days of activism to "Unite to end digital violence against all women and girls".
2. WAVEHI NGO also became a partner of Rise Up Together with the participation of WAVEHI's founder, Lara Rowland in the leadership accelerator program.
